Your care will be managed by a multidisciplinary team of passionate healthcare professionals with experience in oncology including: radiation oncologists, registered nurses, radiation therapists, physicists, and a dedicated team of support staff.

We also offer you access to allied health services including an occupational therapist and exercise physiologist – each offering personalised and supportive care.

Radiation therapy

Radiation therapy uses high energy X-rays or other particles to treat cancer and can be used at all stages.¹

Radiation therapy techniques can include:^{1,2}

- Intensity modulated radiation therapy (IMRT)
- Volumetric modulated arc therapy (VMAT)
- Deep inspiration breath hold (DIBH)
- Cranial stereotactic radiosurgery (SRS)
- Stereotactic ablative body radiotherapy (SABR)
- Image guided radiation therapy (IGRT)
- Specialised non-surgical treatment for skin cancer and some benign conditions

At GenesisCare in Southport we offer you access to a range of allied health services, all tailored to support your needs. One of our treatment team will discuss the most suitable options with you.

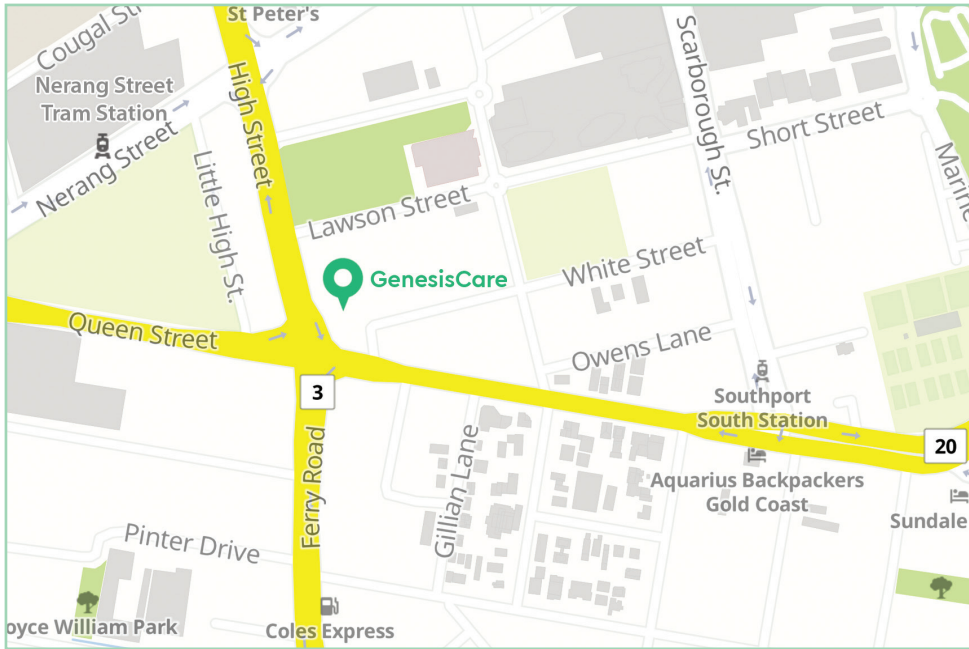
Radiation therapy

- Radiation treatment is typically an outpatient service, with a cost involved for your care
- Private health funds do not cover outpatient services
- Medicare covers approximately 80% of treatment costs (depending on your position within your Medicare Safety Nets)
- Your exact out-of-pocket costs depend on a number of factors including your personal treatment plan, complexity and your position within your Medicare Safety Nets
